

White Eagle Explains Christ's Miracles

Most of us are mystified by miracles because they seem to be beyond our understanding. A miracle, by definition, is considered to be "a supernatural or supernormal event; a deviation or suspension for some reason from Natural Law with the subsequent production of a wondrous act." Spiritualism teaches that the universe is governed by Natural Laws that are immutable and unchangeable, and believe there are can be no occasion when Divine Intelligence - God sets aside or suspends the Natural Law to perform what is referred to as a miracle. In other words, there is no such thing as a miracle.

The question remains. How did Christ turn the water into wine, walk on water, control the elements, and raise the dead? White Eagle's channeled messages came through mediumship of Grace Cook and these teachings are published in numerous books. White Eagle's explanation of the miracles of Christ is taken from a chapter in a book entitled *Jesus - Teacher and Healer*.

White Eagle begins by reminding us about the occurrences of miracles in nature and of mediumship. He states, "Will you remember the miracles which take place in nature every season of every year? A little brown seed is planted in mother earth. Surely it is a never-ending miracle when that little seed bursts its shell, grows into a plant, and produces exquisite flowers, beautiful perfume and luscious fruit to sustain the physical body of man. You can see the miracles of nature taking place all about you, although you are so accustomed to this that it seems perfectly ordinary to you."

In the same way, White Eagle also refers to the miracle of mediumship. "Is it not also a miracle when having laid aside the physical body, a beloved friend is able to make you aware of his love, even to communicate to you certain facts, proving to you that they live on beyond death of the body? Surely it is a miracle! Yes, but it is also a demonstration of Spiritual Law – not a psychic law, but a Spiritual Law."

Before touching on Christ's miracles, White Eagle reminds us to enjoy life... be good, be God – God, who would have you enjoy the gifts and the fruits of the earth, and all the beauties of the earth. Cultivate that higher self which enables us to see the beauty lying behind the physical form of fellow human beings, the animals, the plants, the glorious mountains, the streams, and the wind in the trees and the beauty of the stars. Live harmoniously and in this way you will surely find the God that Jesus told you to love.

Living in harmony with God were the secrets that Jesus completely possessed. According to White Eagle Jesus had passed through schools of training in many, many incarnations before he came to earth. He was not merely master of what you would call Psychic Law, but of the Spiritual Law, the Law of

God, the Creative Law. Records in the gospels show, he was able to create and change physical form; he was able to bring people back to life from apparent death.

What enabled the miracle of walking on water? White Eagle states, “The simple explanation we would give is this; that he was so at one with God the Father that as he walked he did not think of the water beneath his feet; he did not look down fearing he must sink in the water. With utter completeness of attention he thought only of God the Father. Can you catch a fleeting understanding, and glimpse the power which would so sustain the physical body so that it could not sink? We say that by the very act of thinking of God, Jesus was filled with the love and the light of God the Father and so his body became buoyant, no longer of the earth, earthy, but suffused with the light of God.”

What enabled Jesus to control the raging storm? White Eagle explains this phenomenon. “How did he control the elements when the disciples were terrified of drowning because of the storm at sea? When the boat was tossed by the wind and sea, Jesus slept; your Bible says that the disciples were sore afraid, and awakened him crying, “Lord, save us: we perish”. Now remember that Jesus was Master – master of all the elements both without and also within the kingdom of his own being. Those devas and great ones of the angelic kingdom who control the powers of nature would feel the utter harmony, respond to the call of a being who had attained to that perfect mastery. And how had he attended? Through love, through the spirit of peace which dwelt in him.”

How can a man hope to control the elements when he does not know peace within himself? But the Master having completely attained to the peace of God, had won the power of command over the elements – not of himself, not of his own mind and will, but by the power and love of the God within him. We assure you that to be a spiritual scientist, in however small a degree, man has to tread each step of the way by his daily life and aspirations; to tread the path of selflessness, of daily communion with the love of the Father-Mother God, and to set himself on one side. ‘Thy will be done in earth, as it is being done in heaven.’”

What of the changing of water into wine? White Eagle explains, “We only attempt to give you hints of the law underlying physical matter, but we could say that Jesus raised and changed the vibrations of the atoms of which the physical substance was composed. If the vibrations of the atoms in physical matter are changed, the atoms take on a different form. Matter in different forms vibrates at different rates. We want you to understand that for Jesus, working from the creative plane of spirit, it was possible by changing the rate of vibration of the atoms, to change the water into another substance – as, in this instance, he changed it into wine.

It was always by the same method; not of his own power, but by the Father which dwelt in him..... ‘The Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the

works... I and my Father are one.' White Eagle concludes, "We would try to convey to you that Christ the Son, the light of the Logos, completely illuminated the human personality of Jesus of Nazareth."

It is no mystery that Jesus lived in complete harmony with God. He walked the path of selflessness. He was in daily communion with his heavenly Father. He set aside his ego. He had complete trust and knew no fear.

Jesus walked on water because he was able to maintain utter completeness of attention as he thought only of God. He controlled the elements because he was filled throughout his whole being with the love and light of God and the spirit of peace. The water was turned into wine by working from the creative plane of spirit to change the rate of vibration of physical matter to form a new substance.

And most importantly, Jesus understood and always maintained that it was not by his own power that he walked on water, calmed the storm, healed the sick, restored vision to the blind, raised the dead, turned water into wine and multiplied the loaves and fishes to feed the multitude. It by the Father which dwelt in him..... 'The Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works... I and my Father are one.'
